Total amount of recommended bid: \$328,958.38 (5 yr. period)

PROPOSERS

1. Compunet, Inc.
2. Government Technology Solutions, Inc.

Purpose: To establish the most reliable and cost efficient firewall available to the District. The initial cost of \$232,958.38 will pay for the first three years of the contract. If the District is still satisfied with the service and performance, we will pay Compunet, Inc. an additional \$48,000.00 renewal fee for the next two years.

PROPOSAL SELECTED: Compunet, Inc.

Recommendations to the Board of Education: The Purchasing Department recommends placing the orders with Compunet, Inc. as the proposer who scored the highest number of points and who complied with the specifications, terms, and conditions of the RFP. A committee evaluated proposals from two (2) vendors and scored responses on the criteria listed in the RFP. This RFP covers a five-year period.
