PURPOSE: To provide a security door, and a divider door at Daybreak Elementary.

JUSTIFICATION: The current bi-fold door that is located in the gym on the stage is in very poor condition and needs to be replaced. In addition, we are installing a new roll down metal coil door in front of the bi-fold door.

Adding the coil door will address two problems that we are currently having. One, it will protect the bi-fold door from damage that has occurred from basketballs and other gym activities. The second reason is we have a hard time securing the school side from the rec center. At night, and on the weekend, kids are able to push and crawl under the bi-fold door and get into the kitchen area as well as the rest of the school.
