Purpose: To provide a social emotional learning curriculum for grades K-12.

BUDGET: Individual school budgets that utilizes the SEL curriculum

BID SELECTED:

Recommendations to the Board of Education: The Jordan School District solicited Statements of Qualification (SOQ) from established providers of Social Emotional Learning (SEL) curriculum to provide evidence-based, researched, and reviewed materials for grades K-12. The result of this solicitation process will be the placement of qualified SEL curriculum on an Approved Vendor List for individual schools to purchase from. All vendors listed above achieved the minimum threshold scores to qualify. Schools will be required to compare a minimum of three (3) providers on the Approved Vendor List. Beginning in the 2023-24 school year, SEL is a voluntary curriculum that will be paid for by the individual schools that choose to utilize it. However, it is anticipated that over the next 2-3 years the curriculum could become mandatory and the cost would exceed the \$80,000 threshold. For this reason, we are requesting the approval from the Board to move forward with these providers and associated contracts.
